Warren's 32nd Annual Art in the Park

Sponsored by Warren Tri-County Fine Arts, Inc. and Warren Cultural Commission
Halmich Park, 13 Mile Road, between Ryan and Dequindre, July 14 and 15, 2012, 10 AM to 5 PM

Eligibility: Open to artists 18 years and older. Admission to the public is free.

Media: Paintings, sculpture, pottery, jewelry, textiles, photography, glass, stained glass, leather, graphics and wood carving. *All work must be original - no kits, patterns, commercial products, or copies allowed. Work not in good taste or not acceptable will be removed by the committee. Nude subjects are prohibited. No dried or silk flowers.*

Fee: \$125 per exhibiting art space outside, \$135 in the pavilion, plus \$25 nonrefundable jury fee (submit separate checks payable in U.S.funds). Upon acceptance, \$125/\$135 fee is not returnable. Make checks or money order payable to *Art in the Park* and mail with entry applications and slides to Art in the Park, c/o Paula Wild, 8707 Forest Court, Warren, MI 48093. Contact for further information Michael Peychich at 248 259-2315, e-mail MGPPPhotography@gmail.com, or contact Paula Wild at 586 795-5471, *wildart@wowway.com* Include a 9-1/2" x 4" stamped self-addressed envelope with the application.

Jury: Submit via e-mail or a CD (JPEG format) three examples representative of your work (three examples only, please) and one view of your entire display. You must include examples for EACH media you intend to display. Artist's name, media, and size of work must be clearly printed on the CD or e-mail. CDs will be returned ONLY if a self-addressed stamped envelope with adequate postage is included with entry. \$125/\$135 will be returned to any rejected applicant; all other fees are non-refundable. Incomplete applications will be returned. CDs that cannot be returned because of lack of postage may be picked up at the information booth the day of the show. *All work must be for sale.* Decision of the judges is final.

Deadline: See Early Entry offer above. Entries will be accepted until May 10, 2012. Late entries will incur a \$25 late fee. Notice of acceptance or rejection will be mailed by June 1, 2012.

Sales: All sales and proceeds will be transacted by and will go to the artist. Each artist is responsible for the collection and payment of Michigan Sales Tax on all sales made during the show.

Display: Space allotted will be approximately 10' x 10' in the pavilion. Outside space is 12' x 12'. All artists are responsible for cleaning their area at the end of the day. Trash receptacles will be provided. Artists will be responsible for furnishing their own display. All tables must be skirted. To designate a corner location add \$25. Electricity may be available in the pavilion.

Restrictions: No pets allowed. No alcoholic beverages and/or drugs allowed. Hired salespeople are prohibited. No auxiliary utilities (electricity/water), auxiliary power by battery only.

Set-Up: Friday, July 13 after 3 PM (subject to weather conditions). Saturday setup 7 AM to 9:30 AM. Sunday setup 8 AM to 9:30 AM. All vehicles must be removed from the display area to the designated parking area by 9:30 AM Saturday and Sunday. Exhibitor identification card will be included with your welcome packet and must be prominently displayed both days. Spaces will be pre-assigned and are not transferable. Early take down is prohibited.

Awards: Cash awards and ribbons will be presented. Judging will commence at 10 AM on Saturday, July 14. No other awards or ribbons may be displayed.

Misc.: Food, parking and rest room facilities are available. Come prepared for weather elements; plastic covers may be needed. Many areas require the use of tent weights. Extensive advertising is provided for Art in the Park.

Liability: Warren Tri-County Fine Arts, Inc., Warren Cultural Commissions and the City of Warren are not responsible for theft, loss or damage to displays and/or work or personal injury to any participant or helper. All applications must be signed by the artist.
